St Jude's Church Hall

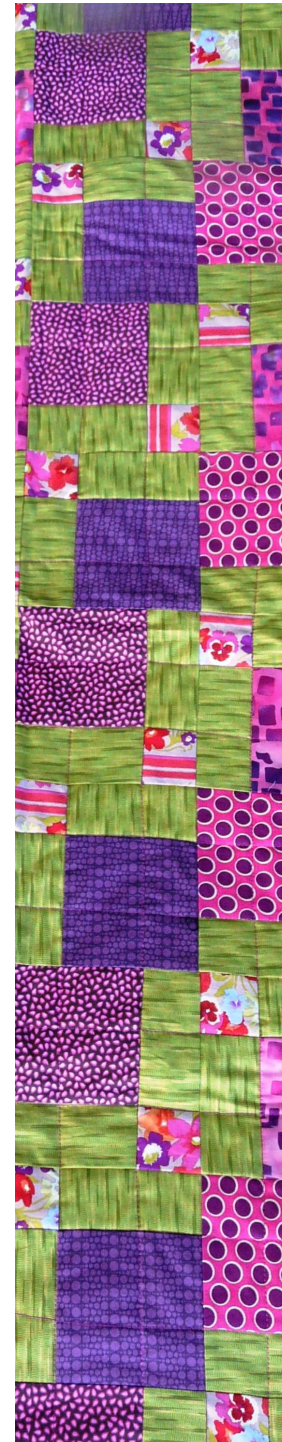
which has ample car parking and good lighting. It is also on the 45 bus route from Nottingham city centre.
